### USE OF AMERICAN HISTORY AND HERITAGE WITHIN THE DISTRICT

- I. It shall be the policy of the Clark County School District that any teacher or administrator employed by the district shall be allowed to read, post, or show any excerpts or portions of writings, documents, and records relating to present and past American history and heritage, including, but not limited to the:
  - A. National Anthem
  - B. Pledge of Allegiance
  - C. National Motto
  - D. Declaration of Independence
  - E. United States Constitution
  - F. Nevada Constitution
  - G. Mayflower Compact
  - H. Writings, speeches, documents, and proclamations of the founding fathers and present and past presidents of the United States
  - I. Writings, speeches, documents, and proclamations of the founders and present and past officials of the State of Nevada
  - J. Federal and state court decisions
  - K. Acts of the Nevada State Legislature
  - L. Acts of the United States Congress, including the published text of the Congressional record
  
- II. It shall be the policy of the Clark County School District that there shall be no content-based censorship of American history or heritage in the district based on religious references in the documents referred to in Section I.
