DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY - BAND UNIFORMS AND CHORAL ROBES

I. To facilitate consistency for Clark County School District student music activities, standards for secondary school band uniforms and choral robes have been established by the District Standards Commission.

A. Band Uniforms

- District funds are budgeted in accordance with available resources for the replacement of senior high school band uniforms after a minimum of ten years use as deemed necessary by the District Material Commission.
- 2. Senior high schools will budget and arrange for the cleaning of band uniforms at the closing of school each year prior to storage of the uniforms during the summer.

B. Choral Robes

- 1. Acquisition of choral robes is the responsibility of individual schools.
- 2. Individual schools will budget and arrange for the cleaning of choral robes at the closing of school each year prior to storage of the robes during the summer.
- II. Students are responsible for the care and maintenance of band uniforms and/or choral robes assigned to them. The District does not accept responsibility for replacement and/or cleaning of the band uniforms or choral robes other than as outlined in this regulation.
