STUDENT BODY FUNDS: MANAGEMENT

- I. The Clark County School District authorizes the establishment of student body funds to finance extracurricular programs that augment school-sponsored activities. Student fund-raising projects shall, in general, contribute to the students' educational experiences and shall not hinder the instructional program.

Administrative regulations and procedures governing student body funds will be consistent with the following guidelines:

- A. Control and expenditure of student body funds shall be in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures for Management of Student Activity and Staff Funds (Regulation 3231).
- B. Student fund-raising projects shall be conducted in such a manner as to offer minimum competition to commercial concerns.
- C. Student body funds shall be collected or solicited insofar as possible from students in the school in which the extracurricular program is conducted. Public solicitation may be permitted when the program to be financed is of interest to the community.
