

# CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT REGULATION

## DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS

R-6174

This program is designed to allow eligible students currently enrolled in the Clark County School District (CCSD) the opportunity to receive credit through accredited institutions of higher education which have a cooperative formal agreement with the District. Course credit (both high school and higher education) shall be awarded and will apply toward graduation requirements of both institutions.

### I. Eligibility

- A. Students in Grades 9–12 are eligible for Dual Enrollment courses unless otherwise noted in formal agreements with community colleges, state colleges, or universities.
- B. Students must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 and meet the requirements outlined in the formal agreement between the institution of higher education and the District.

### II. Procedures

- A. Students wishing to enroll in a Dual Enrollment course must meet with a high school counselor to update the four-year academic plan, and secure the required application and procedure forms.
- B. Students completing college courses outside of a formal cooperative agreement between an institution of higher education and CCSD must meet with a high school counselor and complete a dual credit pre-approval application form. When students have completed the pre-approved courses they shall notify the high school registrar and present transcripts of their final grades. At that time, credit will be verified and granted by the high school.

### III. Granting of Credit

Beginning with the 2022–2023 school year, students who successfully complete a semester-based higher education course, approved by CCSD, of at least three credit hours will be granted up to one-half unit of high school credit.
