FACILITY PLANNING

- I. A Clark County School District Master Plan for educational facilities is developed and amended periodically to provide continuing evaluation of the needs and sufficiency of district facilities.
- II. To ensure the Master Plan is adequate and up-to-date, the District utilizes resources of public utilities and commercial, industrial, and governmental agencies. Appropriate out-of-district consultation services may also be used.

Master Plan development and/or amendment is based on criteria as follows:

- A. Evaluation of current educational programs.
 - B. Estimate of future instructional needs.
 - C. Enrollment history and projection.
 - D. Student capacity inventory.
 - E. Projected site acquisition and building requirements.
 - F. Future financial capabilities.
 - G. Assessed valuation and bonding capacities.
- III. It is the responsibility of the Facilities Division to determine that all planning and specifications for District educational facilities are in accordance with federal guidelines and Nevada statutes.
