

CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT REGULATION

R-7113

CLOSING SCHOOLS

- I. Only the Board of School Trustees is authorized to close or change the function of a Clark County School District school.
 - A. Prior to making a recommendation to close or change the function of a school, the district will initiate studies to explore:
 1. Expanded or specialized educational programs.
 2. District attendance zoning changes.
 3. Other strategies to permit ongoing programs to the extent they are educationally and feasibly sound.
 - B. Upon receipt of a recommendation to close or change the function of a school, the superintendent will initiate action in accordance with Nevada statutes as follows:
 1. Provide thirty days' written notice to the principal, teachers and parents of attending children of the affected school.
 2. Publish notice of the subject, time, and place of the Board meeting at which the recommendation will be considered. Publication will be in a newspaper of general circulation in Clark County at least 10 days prior to the meeting.
- II. A Clark County resident who is aggrieved by a Board decision to close or change the function of a school may request, in writing within 30 days, a Board hearing for reconsideration of the decision.
 - A. The Board hearing will be scheduled within 30 days after receipt of the request. Notice of the time and place of the hearing will be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Clark County at least 10 days prior to the hearing. The decision of the Board after its reconsideration hearing is a final decision subject to judicial review as provided by law.
