### RECENT PARTNERSHIP EVENTS

- "Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters" On January 30-February 1, 2017, more than 7,100 elementary school students, teachers, and chaperones attended the performance of *Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters* held at The Smith Center for the Performing Arts.
- "Drumline" On January 27, 2017, more than 1,300 elementary, middle, and high school students, teachers, and chaperones attended the performance of *Drumline* held at The Smith Center for the Performing Arts.
- "Mentoring Matters Mentor Summit" On January 14, 2017, mentors and mentor groups attended the Mentoring Matters Mentor Summit held at College of Southern Nevada.
- "Las Vegas Philharmonic" On January 10-12, 2017, more than 9,500 fourth grade students, teachers, and chaperones attended the Las Vegas Philharmonic Youth Concerts. The concerts were held at The Smith Center for the Performing Arts.
