

Summer After High School Graduation - How to Support Your Child's Education

- Make sure your child notifies the college they will be attending
- Make sure your child makes arrangements for their final transcript to be sent to the college/university and the NCAA (if the student will participate in college athletics)
- Pay registration fees
- Pay tuition deposit (if required)
- Pay dorm deposit (if required)
- Help your child complete all paperwork for roommate selection
- Determine Meal Plan for your child
- Make sure your child accepts any scholarships
- Complete the Millennium Scholarship Packet over the summer
- Help your child complete all financial aid paperwork
- Plan a budget with your child for the school year
- Make sure all bank accounts are in order
- Apply for a student credit card (if necessary)
- Determine form of communication for your child i.e. cell phone, phone cards
- Encourage your child to find out about any Math/English Placement exams that may be required for enrollment
- Encourage your child to read books on how to survive in college
- Your child needs to registers for fall college courses
- Check with the college for immunization records that may be required for enrollment
- Encourage your child to enroll in Freshmen Orientation Session (may involve going to campus earlier)
- Make travel arrangements with your child
- Encourage your child to write thank you notes to people who helped through the college application process
