Contacting Your Legislative Representative

Your elected officials want to hear from you on the issues you feel are important. Participating in the legislative process is one of the great opportunities we have as U.S. citizens. You may want to keep in mind a few guidelines that could help you as you communicate with legislators.

BE DIRECT: Start your message with a reference to the issue you are writing or calling about: *“My name is John Doe, and I’m writing (calling) in opposition to Assembly Bill 1234, which would require all giraffes to be green.”*

- Don’t just mention the bill number. Legislators are dealing with hundreds of bills, and it’s difficult to remember them all, so be sure to include the topic as well.
- Clearly state your position on the bill or issue: opposed, in favor, proposing an amendment, asking a question, etc. Rambling messages that never make a point are not effective.
- If you’re not writing about a specific bill, just refer to the topic.

BE BRIEF: Legislators have a lot to read. A one- or two-paragraph message will be read. A one- or two-page message may not—it might be given to an aide to summarize or tally. As much as legislators would like to digest every thoughtful letter sent to them, the pace and magnitude of the issues make that nearly impossible. If you prefer phone calls, a few minutes is all it takes—time is precious to you both!

BE YOURSELF: First, include your name. Anonymous input generally isn’t taken seriously. Also if you’re writing or calling your own representative, include the words, *“I live in your district.”* If you are a registered voter, you should also include that information. Legislators always like to know when they are hearing from their own constituents. It’s also a good idea to include your address and phone number in the message, so a legislator can contact you, if necessary.

Second, whenever possible, send your own message, not the message of someone else. “Canned” messages or mass-produced forms are a good way to show the number of people aligned on an issue, but a legislator who receives 200 identical messages might be better persuaded if the messages were representative of personal opinions, not a political machine. Stating why you personally support or oppose an issue will give your message more meaning.

BE RESPECTFUL: Even if you totally disagree with the position the legislator has taken, please show them the respect and courtesy that belongs to the office. Legislators make a big sacrifice in both personal and financial areas to serve in Carson City. A disagreement conveyed with respect will be considered fairly; an abusive letter will be considered offensive and may do more harm to your position than help.

BE CAREFUL: Chances are the legislator to whom you are writing won’t be the only person who sees your correspondence. In addition to a secretary or an aide seeing your message, e-mail messages in particular can be easily forwarded and reproduced. Before you commit anything to print or e-mail, ask yourself if you mind if anyone else reads what you’ve written.
