Notes from January 10, 2008 Meeting

- I. Board Updates were given by Trustee Scow. Discussion included:
 - a. AZAC – public input meeting will be held at Coronado HS on January 14 at 6:00 p.m. Discussion will be on rezoning Lamping ES and deciding on a proposal to take to the Board.
 - b. Other – Green Valley’s random athlete drug testing policy has generated a lot of discussion amongst the community and media. This policy will be presented to the Board at tonight’s meeting.

- II. N.Q.E. updates were given by Ms. Donna Anspach. Discussion included Governor Gibbon’s recent plan to cut \$96 million from K-12 education. N.Q.E. is hosting a Town Hall Meeting on January 16th at 4:30 p.m. (Spring Valley HS). The meeting is to be moderated by Jon Ralston with panel discussions being held by Jeremy Aguero (Applied Analysis), Speaker of the Assembly, Barbara Buckley, Trustee Sheila Moulton and other stakeholders. Governor Gibbons was invited to attend. A flyer was distributed to all parents.

- III. An informative session on the funding of education in Nevada was given by Jeremy Aguero from Applied Analysis. He discussed the fiscal responsibility and the formula that is used to determine this responsibility.

- IV. Open Discussion: The upcoming ParentLink Program was discussed and that it will pilot in several of our region schools: ES: Mitchell, Mack, Galloway, Gibson, Tomiyasu, and Gehring; MS: Miller, Silvestri, and Burkholder; and HS: Foothill. The issue with crossing guards was discussed and also the need for the crossing lights to be changed during semester testing.
