

Johnson Junior High School Standard Student Attire

Walter D. Johnson Junior High School implemented a mandatory Standard Student Attire policy during the 2006-2007 school year. The Standard Student Attire policy was implemented following the guidelines of Regulation 5131. The parents of Johnson Junior High School voted to implement the Standard Student Attire policy by a 65% majority. (That's a better percentage than a presidential election.) A parent/guardian may apply for their child to be exempt from the Standard Student Attire policy in the following two instances:

- 1) When the parent/guardian can demonstrate a bona fide religious objection to wearing the Standard Student Attire;
- 2) When wearing Standard Student Attire is inappropriate due to a verified medical condition.

You are encouraged to review and discuss the Standard Student Attire requirements below with your child. All Standard Student Attire violations will result in disciplinary action in alignment with Regulation 5131 and the school-based progressive discipline plan.

Males

- All standard student attire clothing must conform to the **school colors: white, black, maroon, khaki, grey, or navy blue**
- Pants – school colors only
- Polo Shirts – **with collars** – **solid** colors only (no pattern –no words), in school colors with or without school logo, long or short sleeved
- **No** visible colored T-Shirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, (with the exception of school or team T-Shirts) will be allowed over nor under polo shirts
- **NO** faded or light-blue jeans (Only dark blue jeans allowed with **NO** designs or holes and must be hemmed)
- Denim pants in school colors only
- Sweaters in school colors (no words or logos) worn over approved shirts only
- Sweatshirts/sweat suits – solid in school colors (no words, designs or logos other than the school logo)
- PE clothes are to be worn for PE classes only
- Shorts in school colors only, hemmed and no less than **3** inches above the knees
- Ties permitted in school solid colors only
- **No** facial piercings allowed at all.
- Any zipper hoodies, sweatshirts, jackets, etc. must be taken off upon entry to any building/classroom unless it is a solid school color with no logo and worn properly
- All button down shirts must be kept buttoned at all times
- Students are **NOT** at liberty to modify their attire other than the proper way it should be worn

Females

- All standard student attire clothing must conform to the **school colors: white, black, maroon, khaki, grey, or navy blue**
- Pants – school colors only
- Polo Shirts – **with collars** – **solid** colors only (no pattern –no words), in school colors with or without school logo, long or short sleeved
- **No** visible colored T-Shirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, (with the exception of school or team T-Shirts) will be allowed over nor under polo shirts
- **NO** faded or light-blue jeans (Only dark blue jeans allowed with **NO** designs or holes and must be hemmed)
- Denim pants in school colors only
- Sweaters in school colors (no words or logos) worn over approved shirts only
- Sweatshirts/sweat suits – solid in school colors (no words, designs or logos other than the school logo)
- PE clothes are to be worn for PE classes only
- Shorts, skirts or skorts in school colors only, hemmed and no less than **3** inches above the knees
- Jumpers/dresses in school colors only
- **No** facial piercings allowed at all.
- Any zipper hoodies, sweatshirts, jackets, etc. must be taken off upon entry to any building/classroom unless it is a solid school color with no logo and worn properly
- All button down shirts must be kept buttoned at all times
- Students are **NOT** at liberty to modify their attire other than the proper way it should be worn

Basic solid colors of khaki, navy, and white will be required at all Standard Student Attire schools. Johnson Junior High School will also have burgundy, black and grey as the optional color(s). Johnson JHS will be ordering logo shirts that will be sold in August. If there is a hardship, please contact your school counselor for assistance.
