THE VISION OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES

All students will graduate from high school having the knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values necessary to achieve academically, prosper economically, and participate in democracy.

The Board of School Trustees recognizes that its deliberative process benefits greatly from public input and perspective. Those wishing to address the School Board Student Advisory Committee may sign up to speak by calling the Student Activities Office at 799-8474 during regular business hours and at least 3 hours prior to the scheduled start of the meeting. Alternatively, speakers may sign up in person immediately prior to the beginning of the meeting. Prior to each agenda item being voted on, members of the public are allowed to speak on the item after the Board's discussion and prior to their vote. Customarily, speakers will be called in the order in which they signed up. No person may sign up for another individual. No person may yield his or her time to another person. Generally, a person wishing to speak on agenda items will be allowed 3 minutes to address the Board.
