SCHOOL ZONING FOR THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR FROM GORDON MCCAWE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO ROBERT L. TAYLOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

Rick Baldwin reviewed the rezoning to accommodate the Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math magnet program to be implemented at Gordon McCaw Elementary School for grades 1-5.

Trustee Wright met with principals of both schools and they, as well as city leadership, are very excited about the new program.

Rick Baldwin reviewed the rezoning to accommodate the International Studies magnet program to be implemented at Clarence Piggott Elementary School for grades 1-5.

SCHOOL ZONING FOR THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR FROM CLARENCE PIGGOTT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO ETHEL W. STATON ELEMENETARY SCHOOL.

Rick Baldwin reviewed the rezoning of unpopulated future development to accommodate the International Studies magnet program to be implemented at Clarence Piggott Elementary School.

Trustee Tew asked that the recommendation be amended to include the area north of Far Hills/Far Hills Extension, west of CC 215, south of Lake Mead Boulevard/Lake Mead Extension to the Red Rock Corporate Limit from William Lummis Elementary School to Ethel W. Staton Elementary School.

Rick Baldwin stated there are no students in this area.

Trustee Edwards asked if this change makes it a contiguous area with Staton Elementary School.

Rick Baldwin stated it does make it a contiguous area.

SCHOOL ZONING FOR THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR FROM CAROLYN S. REEDOM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO CHARLES AND PHYLLIS FRIAS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

Rick Baldwin reviewed the recommended change for students in grades K-5 from Carolyn S. Reedom Elementary School to Charles and Phyllis Frias Elementary School.

Trustee Edwards stated concern about moving students when there is the possibility that the State Legislature will approve bonds to build new schools in the Clark County School District.

Public Hearing

Jennifer Weingardner, parent of two students at Carolyn S. Reedom Elementary School, is concerned about access from her development and getting her children to school in a timely manner because the current two minute drive would be extended to 10 to 15 minutes. She recommended another area be zoned to Frias Elementary School.

Trustee Garvey asked if any conversation came up during public input meetings about potential capping or double sessions.

Rick Baldwin stated those discussions are out of the purview of AZAC, so they were not mentioned. Mr. Baldwin stated there were only 10-12 parents in attendance at the public input meeting.

Trustee Edwards stated she was in attendance at the public input meeting and agreed there were not many parents there. She has received approximately 10 emails since then from parents. Trustee Edwards explained that capping does not affect the students currently enrolled. She also commented that there would be bussing required due to safety concerns with the zone change.

SCHOOL ZONING FOR THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR FROM WALTER JOHNSON JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL TO SIG ROGICH MIDDLE SCHOOL.

Rick Baldwin reviewed the need to move the area zoned from Rogich Middle School to Johnson Junior High School last year back to Rogich Middle School due to the implementation of an International Studies Magnet program at Johnson Junior High School.

Trustee Tew asked that the recommendation be amended to include the area north of Far Hills/Far Hills Extension, west of CC 215, south of Lake Mead Boulevard/Lake Mead Extension to the Red Rock Corporate Limit from Ernest Becker Middle School to Sig Rogich Middle School.

Motion by the Board of School Trustees to accept the recommendation to reassign the area as described and as amended above, From Walter Johnson Junior High School and Ernest Becker Middle School to Sig Rogich Middle School as reflected on agenda item 2.05.

Rick Baldwin explained the recommendations in agenda items 2.06 and 2.07 are made to clean the file due to the change in manner of defining zones in Infinite Campus. The old method was based upon street boundaries while Infinite Campus is based upon parcels. No students will be moved. He added that

agenda item 2.08 was requested by transportation. In the event students move into the Calville Bay area in the future, there would be a considerable saving of time and finances to bus the students to Sewell Elementary School, Brown Junior High School and Basic High School.

Trustee Young requested the three recommendations be considered together. There was no objection from the Board of School Trustees.
