COMMUNITY LINKAGE

Presentation and discussion on the Nevada Growth Model and the School Performance Framework, including a time for questions from members of the audience, as requested.

Trustee Cole and Trustee Cranor explained the purpose of today's meeting and what would be presented to the audience. They thanked everyone for attending the meeting and for their participation.

Superintendent Jones talked about the discussions that District staff, community members, community partners, and parents have been having about how to help children succeed academically and the programs and systems being developed through those conversations.

Dr. Turner briefly explained the School Performance Framework (SPF) and the Nevada Growth Model. He guided audience members through the SPF High School Survey, which was designed to gather input from community members concerning an SPF for high schools.

Audience members watched a short video which gave an overview of the SPF.

Dr. Turner demonstrated how to access and navigate the SPF and the Nevada Growth Model on the CCSD website.

Mr. Martinez commented further on ways in which the District is working to support all students with available resources through teachers and administrators at different schools learning from one another.

Trustee Cole facilitated the question-and-answer segment of the meeting, reading audience member questions from cards to which Superintendent Jones, Mr. Martinez, and Dr. Turner responded.
