INTRODUCTIONS

Tracy Murphy introduced AZAC commissioners, Clark County School District staff and Trustee Lola Brooks. Ms. Murphy gave a brief presentation of the AZAC rules, regulations and public input process.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Tracy Murphy reviewed Attendance Zone Advisory Commission's proposal to establish an attendance boundary for the new school opening 2017 on Antelope Ridge Drive and adjust the attendance zone boundaries of Linda Rankin Givens Elementary School and Ethel W. Staton Elementary School.

PUBLIC INPUT

One parent asked that the new school offer programming and extracurricular activities as good as or better than currently offered at Givens Elementary School.

One parent asked that fifth grade students be allowed to stay at their current school.

Two parents expressed concern that there will not be sufficient enrollment for proper funding. Of the two immediately above, one also expressed opposition to zone variances being allowed at Givens Elementary School and one expressed opposition to Open Enrollment, but was in favor of zone variances so only students in the area would be accepted, providing relief for overcrowding at area schools.

Tracy Murphy informed the public AZAC will make their final zoning recommendations to forward to the Board of School Trustees at the meeting to be held on Tuesday, January 24, 2017, 9:30 a.m. in the Board Room of the Edward A. Greer Education Center. Zoning recommendations will be voted upon by the Board of School Trustees at a special board meeting on February 22, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Edward A. Greer Education Center.
