One of the longest running programs within the Clark County School District's School-Community Partnership Office is the Professionals and Youth Building a Commitment (PAYBAC) Program. For more than twenty years, community volunteers have visited middle and alternative high school classrooms as guest speakers.

PAYBAC speakers share with students their own story by incorporating their educational experience, work life, and their struggles and obstacles in
