AUTHORIZATION OF LEGAL ACTION

- I. The Board of School Trustees recognizes that the District may be named as a defendant in various types of lawsuits or administrative actions. The Board of School Trustees authorizes the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee, with the approval of legal counsel, to initiate appeals or other proceedings necessary to contest decisions or judgments entered in cases as determined in the best interests of the District.
- II. The Board of School Trustees authorizes the Superintendent of Schools, with the approval of legal counsel, to initiate legal actions, join legal actions, or file legal briefs supporting interests of the District in separate legal proceedings when determined in the best interests of the District.
- III. Actions taken under Section I above shall be reported to the Board of School Trustees no later than the second regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of School Trustees after the filing authorized under Section I.
- IV. Actions taken under Section II above, except for the filing of lawsuits intended to recover no more than \$100,000, shall be reported to the Board of School Trustees no later than the second regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of School Trustees after the filing authorized under Section II.
- V. Nothing in this Regulation shall restrict the authority of the Board of School Trustees to direct the Superintendent with regard to Clark County School District litigation.
- VI. Resolution of claims against the District will be handled as described in Clark County School District Regulation 3432.
