### **GRADUATION PATHWAYS**

Presentation and discussion on different academic pathways for high school students.

Dr. Barton gave an overview of the Grade Point Average (GPA) Cap, pipeline, dual credits, dual enrollment, College of Southern Nevada (CSN) Jumpstart, Policy and Regulation 6174, Advance Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB), Career and Technical Education (CTE), and Perkins 5.

Mr. Gregorius gave an overview of the diploma types, credits, endorsements, National Career Ready Certificate (NCRC), CPR, College Ready Endorsement, Smarter Balance Assessment Consortium (SBAC), Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) scores, academic planning, and Culinary.

Committee members discussed the different types of diplomas, certificates, SAT's, American College Testing (ACT), Preliminary Scholastic Assessment Test (PSAT), mental health services, social workers, teacher observations, and pathways to college.
